

# Opportunities For Service—OFS

Each family is required to do 10 hours of service (or pay \$150) during the academic year. There are many, many ways to be involved in the life of our school. Below is a list of events and organizations where, if we have many involved, everyone benefits. There will be more details in the August Mailer.

**Standing Committees/Commissions:** *If you are on one of these committees your service hours are fulfilled.*

School Advisory Committee, Parish Council, Parish Life, Finance Commission, Stewardship Committee, Phase III Task Force & Athletic Booster Chairperson.

**School Events:** *These are bigger events and tasks will be broken down. Many of these our parent organization (SEASPA) did—however, we do not have a specific chairperson anymore for that. You will be asked to sign in at meetings/events. People who "chair" an event automatically fulfill their service hours.*

Fish Fry Team, Spring Fling Team, Family Night (1st Trimester), Family Night (2nd Trimester)=Taco/Bingo Night, Family Night (3rd Trimester), Catholic Schools Week & Bake Sales, Staff Luncheons.

**Fundraisers:** *Each fundraiser varies with times needed and the duration of the event. People who "chair" the event automatically fulfill their service hours.*

Marathon for Non-Public Education (Oct.), Magazine Sales (Oct./Nov.), Market Day (1-2 hrs. Monthly)

**At School:** *These are the typical things we have had on the volunteer form and for which the time commitment can vary and is very flexible. Some of these also allow you to bring younger children with when volunteering and several are during the school day. People who take on a leadership role will likely fulfill their service hours.*

Lunchroom & Playground Supervisor, Kitchen Helper, Room Parent/Leader, Classroom helper, Social Events/Hospitality (getting goodies arranged and set out i.e. concerts, conferences, etc.), Office helper, Computer Lab Assistant, Library Assistant, Science Supply Room Coordinator

**At Home Or After School Hours:** *These are things that come up periodically. A great way for someone to get in their time in the evening or on a weekend.*

Phone calling, Yearbook, Baking, Classroom or Office Projects (cutting things out or tallying), Cleaning the school, General maintenance when needed, building/constructing things, Coaching.
