

## Uniform Standards at a Glance

### Boys (K-5)

- Light blue polo shirt with embroidered logo
- Light blue oxford shirt with collar
- Light blue turtleneck
- Navy or white socks
- Navy blue cotton twill or corduroy slacks
- Navy blue cardigan sweater
- SEAS uniform sweatshirt with current logo
- Navy blue walking shorts when weather permits
- Navy, Brown or Black shoes. White sneakers are acceptable as long as they are relatively plain (no light ups, logos minimized and no colored shoelaces)

### Girls (K-5)

- Plaid jumper
- Plaid skirt (grades 3-5 only)
- Light blue blouse with peter pan collar
- Light blue polo shirt with embroidered logo
- Light blue turtleneck
- Navy blue cardigan sweater
- Navy or white knee-high or ankle socks. Navy tights are also acceptable
- Navy blue walking shorts when weather permits
- Navy blue cotton twill or corduroy slacks
- Hair accessories must be uniform colors-blue (light or navy), white, or made from the same material as the jumper. Bandanas are not allowed.
- Navy, Brown or Black shoes. White sneakers are acceptable as long as they are relatively plain (no light ups, logos minimized and no colored shoelaces)

### Non-Uniform (middle school and K-5 out of uniform days)

- all students must wear shirts with sleeves
- "pajama" style pants are not allowed
- Sloppy and/or oversized sweatpants/athletic pants are not allowed
- Frayed, ripped or tattered clothing is not acceptable
- No hats or bandanas worn during the school day
- Shorts/skirts must be appropriate length
- Boys: Jeans must fit (no boxers showing)
- Girls: shirts must fit with modesty in mind (not too tight or too low)
- Boys and girls: No undergarments may be showing at any time
- On Mass days students are expected to dress up a bit. Tops with large writing and hooded sweatshirts are not allowed on Mass days. **Elementary students should always in uniform on Mass days.**
